

# **MONTHLY BULK WASTE PICKUP**

If your regular trash service day is:

- Monday = your bulk waste pick-up is the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month.
- Tuesday = 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month
- Wednesday = 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month
- Thursday/Friday = 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month

Items **must be within 2 feet of the curb**. Items should be set at least 5 feet from poly-carts, mailboxes, gas meters, cars, shrubs, or anything else that could interfere with the mechanical lifting arm. For the same reason, items should be set at least 10 feet away from utility poles, to prevent contact with overhead power lines.

**Waste Connections will pick up as much as 3 cubic yards of bulk waste.**

## **The following items can be picked up:**

- Large and small household appliances
- Furniture
- Carpets (4-foot-long bundles)
- Large cardboard boxes (broken down and tied into tight bundles)
- Mattresses
- Trees and limbs (4-foot-long bundles)
- Fencing (4-foot-long bundles)
- Non-Contracted remodeling waste (leftovers from do-it-yourself projects), all items must be contained. No loose materials will be picked up.

## **The following items cannot be picked up:**

- Appliances containing Freon
- Hospital/medical waste
- Oils
- Poisons
- Acids and Caustics
- Explosives
- Bricks, dirt and rocks
- Sewage and liquid waste
- Nuclear materials
- Gasoline, kerosene, and other fuels
- Propane tanks
- Degreasers
- Lubricants
- Tires and rims
- Brake fluid
- Antifreeze
- Car batteries
- Automobile frames
- Crankcases or transmissions
- Automobile parts, engine cleaners, fuel injectors, motor oils, etc.
- Rust remover
- Pool chemicals
- Pesticides
- Fertilizer
- Sheetrock or roofing materials
- Contracted tree and grass trimmings
- Contracted construction, reconstruction, demolition, and repair waste
